



ESSEX COUNTY, WANT TO TAKE IN-HOME COVID-19 TESTS?

COVID-19 has hit hard. 1 in 3 COVID-19 deaths in New Jersey are in the Black and Latino communities. If this concerns you, please participate in **NJ HEROES TOO**, a research study funded by the National Institutes of Health (NIH) focused on increasing COVID-19 testing.

In this study, you:



- Complete a 15-20 minute survey.



- Give a mailing address to get the FDA-approved test kit.



- Give an email address or phone number to get the results.



- Spit in a tube and mail it back.
- Get a \$35 gift card when you complete a survey and a test.



- Can invite your family and friends to participate.

To participate, you should:

- Identify as Black or Latino.
- Live in Essex, Passaic, Middlesex or Union County.
- Give parental/legal guardian consent for those age 4 to 17.

Benefits to you:

- Help your family members know if they have the virus.
- Protect your household, neighborhood and community.
- Reliable test kits and results.
- Use it in the privacy and comfort of your home.
