

Programs to Help Pay Your PSE&G Bill



Income limits for each program can be found below.

New Jersey Energy Assistance Programs

Universal Service Fund (USF)/Fresh Start Program (FSP)

- Income-eligible customers can receive a \$5-180 monthly USF credit toward their energy bill. Applications are accepted year-round.
- The Fresh Start Program (part of the USF program) offers forgiveness of past-due balances of over \$60.

Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)

- Income-eligible customers can receive an average of \$300 toward their energy bill. Applications are accepted from October 1 to June 30.
- If you apply for LIHEAP, you are also applying for USF.

Payment Assistance Gas and Electric (PAGE)

- Income-eligible customers must have a balance on their bill of at least \$100 and be past due. Applications are accepted year-round.
- To qualify for PAGE, customers who are eligible for USF and LIHEAP must first apply for those programs and then if they meet PAGE requirements, can apply for PAGE.

NJ SHARES (NJS)

- Income-eligible customers can receive up to \$700 for electric or \$700 for gas, depending on the balance owed on their energy bill. Applications are accepted year-round.
- NJ SHARES is available for customers who do not qualify for USF or LIHEAP, but do not exceed the income limits for NJ SHARES.

NJ Lifeline

- Income-eligible senior citizens who are at least 65 years old and disabled adults who are at least 18 years old and receive Social Security Disability Title II can receive a yearly credit of \$225. Applications are accepted year-round.
- Applicant's annual gross income (not the household income) must be less than \$42,142 if single or less than \$49,209 if married.

Energy Efficiency Programs

Comfort Partners

- Income-eligible customers may qualify for a free energy efficiency assessment, energy efficiency upgrades, and health and safety improvements at no cost. Both homeowners and renters are eligible.
- Customers may also qualify if they participate in certain social safety net programs.

PSE&G's Home Weatherization Program for Income-Qualified Customers

- Income-eligible customers may qualify for a free energy efficiency assessment and up to \$7,500 in energy efficiency, health and safety improvements at no cost.
- If customers don't qualify for Comfort Partners, they may be eligible for the Home Weatherization Program.
